Opportunities for Emergency Relief in Ukraine

For philanthropists who feel compelled to support those affected by the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, below is a curated list of non-profit organizations. We recognize that this list is not comprehensive as there are countless organizations providing support, and we encourage your own further research and reflection.

Advocacy/Civic Engagement

- [Razom for Ukraine](#)
 - Razom’s (Razom means “together” in Ukrainian) emergency response is focused on purchasing medical supplies for critical situations like blood loss and other tactical medical items, and amplifying the voices of Ukrainians. Funds raised in their current emergency campaign will be used to purchase tourniquets, bandages, combat gauzes, sterile pads, and satellite phones. They are coordinating efforts with partner organizations, governments, and embassies.

 - CARE is providing immediate aid including food, water, hygiene kits, support services, and direct cash assistance.

- The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is working closely with the Ukrainian Red Cross Society to support people with emergency assistance including food, water, and other essential items. They are also supporting hospitals and primary care facilities with medical equipment and other emergency preparedness. They repair water stations and support households to rehabilitate damaged homes, and help reconnect families separated by the conflict.

- MSF is ensuring that people have access to health care and medicine. They also run a range of activities in Ukraine working with local volunteers, organizations, health care professionals, and authorities.

- Project HOPE coordinates with health care workers to provide on-the-ground medical support to countries in crisis. Their emergency teams are sending medical supplies and medicines to assist Ukrainians, and are standing by to provide health screening and care for refugees and those who are unable to flee the country safely.

 - UNICEF’s emergency interventions include prepositioning health, hygiene, and emergency education supplies as close as possible to communities near the line of contact; trucking safe water to conflict-affected areas; supporting mobile child protection teams providing psychosocial care to children traumatized by chronic insecurity, responding to cases of violence and abuse against children separated from family; and working with municipalities to ensure there is immediate help for children and families in need.
